### PRIVATE FEES 2023

Not all work doctors are asked to do is paid for by the NHS. The NHS only pays for NHS work. Any work outside of the NHS must be funded by other means and this is why fees are charged. Below are our current fees for non-NHS services.

Payment must be made at Reception, either by cheque or cash, prior to the work being undertaken.

**TRAVEL/OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH VACCINATIONS**

<b><u>Hepatitis B</u></b>	<b><u>Cost</u></b>
<p>Hepatitis B (course of 3 injections, and blood test)</p> <p>For occupational health reasons, costs to be borne by <u>employer</u>.</p> <p>If a patient is <u>self-employed</u>, but needs Hep B for occupational health, then, as we cannot charge the patient direct, we can make arrangements with another local practice for Hep B vaccinations to be given privately.</p> <p>Hepatitis B is available on the <u>NHS</u> for the following reasons only:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Infants born of mothers who are Hep B positive.</li><li>2) Infants who have started their vaccination programme abroad, and need it to be completed.</li><li>3) Patients with renal failure receiving, or due to receive, dialysis.</li><li>4) Foster parents of Hepatitis B positive children.</li><li>5) IV drug abusers.</li></ol>	£150
Hepatitis B Booster	£50
Yellow Fever Vaccination, including certificate	£100
Duplicate vaccination certificate	£20
Private prescription for <b>overseas travel</b> , eg. anti-malarial drugs, rabies, Japanese encephalitis; acetazolamide; chicken pox.	
Cost for issuing prescription	£20
Nurse time for each injection	£10
Don't forget, purchase of drug is extra
